

FINAL NOTICE FROM FEMA ON THE ENDING OF TRANSITIONAL SHELTERING ASSISTANCE (TSA)

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Transitional Sheltering Assistance (TSA) ends on Thursday, March 12, 2009 for this disaster. This notice is to inform you that FEMA will no longer pay for your hotel effective checkout time Friday, March 13, 2009, because one or more of the following applies to you:

- You are not eligible for FEMA Temporary Housing
- You were referred to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Disaster Housing Assistance Program (DHAP) and are currently being assisted under that program or HUD has reported they have ended your participation in DHAP
- You advised FEMA that you are no longer in need of shelter assistance
- FEMA has offered you several rental resources for temporary housing that you have not taken
- You advised FEMA that you have no plans to find temporary or long-term housing
- FEMA has been unable to contact you to discuss your case and you have not contacted FEMA

If you remain in the hotel beyond check out time on Friday, March 13, 2009, you will be responsible for any further costs.
