

Notice from FEMA

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) recently authorized you to move into a hotel because you were unable to return to your pre-disaster home. When you first registered with the hotel, you were informed that you were authorized to stay until October 14, 2008.

This notice is to inform you that FEMA has granted you an extended stay in the hotel and that FEMA will no longer continue to pay for your hotel effective Tuesday, October 28, 2008, because one of the following applies to you:

- As a result of our inspection, FEMA has determined that you can live in your home

OR

- at the time you registered, you indicated that you had no home damage or your home damage was unknown and we have not heard from you to schedule an inspection

OR

- at the time you registered, you indicated that you had homeowner's insurance and we advised you to contact your insurance company.

If you remain in the hotel beyond check out time on Tuesday, October 28, 2008, you will be responsible for any further costs.
